Mass in Lincoln Cathedral – 11th April 2019: All are welcome to join the priests, deacons, religious and faithful of Lincoln Deanery to celebrate Mass in Lincoln Cathedral at 7.00 pm on Thursday 11th April.

Melwood Pilgrimage – 4th May 2019: Beginning at noon, the Rosary will be said and Mass will be celebrated on Saturday 4th May at the site of Melwood Priory, a mediaeval Carthusian house that was suppressed during the Dissolution of the Monasteries, on Melwood Hill, which is between Epworth & Owston Ferry to the south-west of Scunthorpe. The last prior, St Augustine Webster, refused to take the oath of supremacy at the beginning of the Reformation; he was subsequently imprisoned in the Tower of London and martyred. There is an annual diocesan pilgrimage to Melwood, which is now in our deanery, and this year Fr Andrew will be Celebrant with Deacon Liam Carpenter preaching the homily.

Please pray for Angela, Rob & Ruth, who will receive the sacraments of initiation during the Easter Vigil. They will be presented to the parish at 11.00 Mass this Sunday.
