The Chrism Mass – 17th April 2019: The Chrism Mass, in St Barnabas' Cathedral this coming Wednesday, is the highpoint of the diocesan year, when the priests renew their commitment and the Bishop blesses the Oil of Catechumens and the Oil of the Sick and consecrates the Sacred Chrism; please contact Moira (01472 324188) for a place on the coach from our parish to the Chrism Mass. Two of our extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, Maureen Wells & Pat Wilson, will be assisting during the liturgy, and the Oils will be welcomed into the parish at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday.

Easter Sunrise Service – 21st April 2019: All are welcome to Churches Together in North East Lincolnshire's Sunrise Service at 5.40 am on Easter Sunday, meeting on the foreshore near Cleethorpes Boating Lake, DE35 0AG.

Easter Vigil – 20th April 2019: This Mass is the heart of the whole liturgical year and will begin on Holy Saturday night at 8.30 pm with the blessing of the Easter fire and lighting of the Paschal Candle outside St Mary on the Sea Church. After the Easter Vigil, there will be a **shared table**; please bring what you can! Please pray for Rob, who will be baptised, Ruth & Angela, who will be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church, and Katarzyna & Jarosław, who will be confirmed during the Easter Vigil, and Charlie & Chloe, who will be baptised during 9.15 am Mass in Corpus Christi Church on Sunday 28th April, the Second Sunday of Easter.

Holy Hour & Crowning of Our Lady – 5th May 2019: May is dedicated to Our Lady, and we will begin the month with Holy Hour in Our Lady Star of the Sea Church at 3.00 pm on Sunday 5th May, which will conclude with the Crowning of Our Lady and will be followed by light refreshments. All are welcome.

The Holy Places: There will be a collection for the Holy Places before each Celebration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday. This collection supports the Church's pastoral, educational, social and cultural mission in the

Holy Land, together with the upkeep and repair of the Holy Places, some fifty shrines that are dear to us because they mark the places where Our Lord and his disciples lived, including the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, which marks where he died and rose in glory. Please be generous!

Holy Week 2019: Please take one of the cards listing the Holy Week liturgies to keep yourself – and at least one other to give to a relative, friend or neighbour whom you will be inviting to join you to celebrate Christ's Passion, Death & Resurrection! Please do enter into the spirit of this week by coming to the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday and most importantly the Easter Vigil next Saturday night. The image on the front of the card is a fresco by Fra' Angelico in St Mark's Convent in Florence.

Italian Night – 11th May 2019: Our next social event will be an Italian night in the parish hall on Saturday 11th May. We will be entertained with background music and photographs from last year's parish pilgrimage to Rome & Assisi. Tickets cost £5.00 per person, including food, and are available from the Social & Fundraising Group. Bring your own drink. Come along and share the fun!

Lent Breakfasts conclude this Sunday in the parish hall after 9.15 am Mass, and **Lent Lunches** in St Mary's Presbytery after 11.00 am Mass. Our First Holy Communion candidates are doing their Easter project, thirty acts of kindness, for Mary's Meals.

Maundy Thursday: There is an ancient tradition that gifts for the poor are brought to the Altar along with the bread and wine for the Eucharistic Sacrifice during the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday. This year, the offertory collection at the Mass of the Lord's Supper will conclude our Lenten alms collection for Mary's Meals. Please be generous!

Our Lady of Lourdes: Fr Andrew will be on pilgrimage in Lourdes with our parish's HCPT group between Easter Monday and Easter Friday, where he will offer Mass for the people of our parish in the grotto. From Pope Francis: Lent invites us to look upward with prayer, which frees us from a horizontal, flat life, where we find time only for our ego, but forget God, and to look to others too with charity. It is the time to rediscover that the Lord is our destination; the course must be set on him.
