Melwood Pilgrimage – 4th May 2019: Beginning at noon, the Rosary will be said and Mass will be celebrated this Saturday, 4th May, at the site of Melwood Priory, a mediaeval Carthusian house that was suppressed during the Dissolution of the Monasteries, on Melwood Hill, between Epworth & Owston Ferry to the south-west of Scunthorpe, and is approximately 45 minutes' drive from Grimsby (Low Melwood Farm, Epworth, DONCASTER DN9 1AD). The last prior, St Augustine Webster, refused to take the oath of supremacy at the beginning of the Reformation; he was subsequently imprisoned in the Tower of London and martyred at Tyburn on 4th May 1535 along with Ss John Houghton, Robert Lawrence & Richard Reynolds. There is an annual diocesan pilgrimage to Melwood, which is in our deanery, and this year Fr Andrew will be Celebrant with Deacon Liam Carpenter preaching.
