Anointing of the Sick – 7th July 2019: There will be an opportunity to gather for the celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick & Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 2.00 pm on Sunday 7th July in St Mary on the Sea Church, followed by strawberry tea & entertainment in St Mary's Catholic Primary Academy. We all need healing, and so everyone is welcome to pray for and receive sacramentally the Lord's healing and embrace on Sunday 7th July. Any parishioner who wishes to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick simply needs to contact St Mary's Presbytery (01472 342301) and Fr Andrew will visit them as soon as possible.

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held this Monday, 24th June, beginning with Mass at 7.00 pm in Corpus Christi Church and continuing in the parish hall. All are welcome!

CARE: During July, we will have our annual collection of food for the food larder, which does so much to support local families who are in need. Please bring any offerings of food and leave them in front of the communion rail in St Mary on the Sea Church, in front of the Altar in Corpus Christi Church, and on the dais behind the Altar in Our Lady Star of the Sea Church.

The suggested Mass offering in the Diocese of Nottingham is £10.00. Please place your offering in one of the brown Mass offering envelopes provided in each church and return it to Fr Andrew or Sr Ann Helen.
