A very warm welcome to our visitors & holidaymakers and those joining us for the first time!

Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for August: That families, through their life of prayer and love, become ever more clearly 'schools of true human growth'.

Cycle of Prayer: During the summer of Ordinary Time, we pray for: a deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; those who suffer persecution, oppression & the denial of human rights; Europe; human life; and seafarers. We also pray for Fr Colum, Fr Tony, Deacon Richard, the sick & housebound of our parish, the mission of our parish schools, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Admission to Hospital: If you or a relative are admitted to the Diana Princess of Wales Hospital, please ask your named nurse to inform the hospital chaplaincy that you would like to see a Catholic priest or contact St Mary's Presbytery directly; Fr Andrew will then visit as soon as is practicable. Unless he knows you're there he cannot visit you, and he will only know if you let him know!

Announcements during Mass: If a parishioner has a significant birthday or wedding anniversary and would like to be included in the prayer of the faithful at Mass, please let Fr Andrew know at least 48 hours in advance; the person's consent must be sought to avoid embarrassment and to protect sensitive personal data – not everyone wants others to know their age! It is possible for those who are celebrating significant wedding anniversaries (silver, pearl, ruby, gold, diamond & platinum) to receive a blessing during Mass; again, please contact Fr Andrew at least 48 hours in advance. Thank you!

First Holy Communion: Parents of children who will be in Year 3 or above in school year 2019-2020 who would like their children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Blessed Eucharist next year should complete an application form, available from the back of each church, and hand it directly to Father Andrew at the end of Sunday Mass by Sunday 8th September 2019 at the latest.

Mass Intentions: Asking for Mass to be offered for a specific intention is a beautiful way of asking our parish family to pray for that intention and, by giving an offering, you support the mission of the Church in our parish. Please give at least three months' notice if you wish Mass to be offered for a specific intention on a specific day in a specific church; if it is not possible to offer the Mass on the requested date, e.g., if there is no Mass that day or there is already a Mass intention. If you do not have a specific date in mind, it will be offered as soon as is practicable. Mass intentions are published in the bulletin and announced during the prayer of the faithful. The suggested Mass offering in the Diocese of Nottingham is £10.00. Please place your offering in one of the brown Mass offering envelopes provided in each church and return it to Fr Andrew or Sr Ann Helen.

Mobile Telephones: Please ensure that your **mobile phone is switched off** when you come into church; they not only disturb other people when they go off, but also disrupt the celebration of Mass and the reflective silence that should precede it. Thank you for your cooperation!

Parish Summer Barbeque – 25th August 2019: This year's summer barbeque will give people the opportunity to gather at Our Lady Star of the Sea Church next Sunday, 25th August, from 1.00 pm, with food being served from 1.30 pm – a great way to mark the bank holiday weekend! Tickets cost just £5.00, which is great value for money, and are on sale from members of the Social & Fundraising Group. We are also looking for raffle prizes – please leave anything clearly labelled at the back of each church or in St Mary's Presbytery.

Pastoral Visits at Home: Please contact St Mary's Presbytery if you would like Fr Andrew to visit you at home, whether it is because you would like to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, or would just like to have a chat. If you would like to receive Holy Communion at home, either on a temporary or a more permanent basis, please get in touch with the Presbytery; in the first instance, Fr Andrew will visit you before arranging for an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion to visit you on a regular basis, weekly, fortnightly or monthly as you prefer.

The Sacrament of Baptism is the foundation of the Christian life. The next preparation course will now take place on Thursday 26th September at 7.00 pm in Holy Trinity Parish Hall. Parishioners who would like their children to be baptised should complete the form at the back of each church and return it to Fr Andrew after Sunday Mass; this can be done before the child has been born. Once Fr Andrew has signed the form and the course has been completed, a date & time will be set for the Baptism.
