The Vigil Mass will be preceded by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament & the Sacrament of Reconciliation at 6.15 pm with Benediction at 6.45 pm.

**All Souls' Day, Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> November**, is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed; in addition to the Vigil Masses that evening, Mass will be celebrated at 10.00 am in St Mary on the Sea Church.
