CAFOD Lent Family Fast Day – 6th March 2020: Our parish's CAFOD representatives will give a short talk at Mass this weekend about Lent Family Fast Day, which gives us the opportunity to miss a meal and donate its cost, in next weekend's second collection, to help the poorest people in the world; please take an envelope today and return it next weekend, and if you are a UK taxpayer please complete the Gift Aid Declaration.

Coronavirus: Like the common cold, coronavirus infection usually occurs through close contact with a person with novel coronavirus via coughs, sneezes or hand contact. A person can also be infected by touching contaminated surfaces if they do not wash their hands. We are reminded to follow Public Health England advice to:

- Always carry tissues and use them to catch your cough or sneeze – then bin the tissue, and wash your hands with soap and water or use a sanitiser gel.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, or use a hand sanitiser, especially after using public transport.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are unwell.
