**Stay alert – Control the virus – Save lives**

**Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for September:** We pray that the planet's resources will not be plundered but shared in a just and respectful manner.

**Cycle of Prayer** – during the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for Fr Colum, Fr Tony, the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, all those who are working to protect us, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

**Celebrating Sunday Mass:** If you wish to enter the ballot for 11.00 am Mass next Sunday, 5<sup>th</sup> September 2020, email or telephone the parish office (office@holyltrinitygci.uk; 01472 342301) during office hours on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday this week, indicating how many seats you would like to reserve for you and members of your own household; you will be contacted on Friday with the outcome. Only those whose names are drawn in the ballot can be admitted, up to a maximum of fifty, and there will be a reserve list in case someone drops out. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended.

**Celebrating Weekday Mass:** Admission to church for weekday Mass is on a first-come, first-served basis up to a maximum of fifty attendees.

**Coming into Church:** Whether you are coming to church for Mass or for private individual prayer, please bear in mind that social distancing must be observed in the car park and in the church itself, which means that a maximum of fifty people can be in the church for Mass; for baptisms, weddings and funerals, the maximum is thirty, with admittance by prior arrangement. **Face coverings must be worn in church unless someone is exempt.** Stewards will guide those coming into the church; no one who is displaying symptoms of Covid-19 or any other transmissible illness should come into the church; under 16s must be accompanied by an adult; people from different households should not share lifts; care should be taken in the car park to avoid close contact with other vehicles and their occupants; you will have to sign in and leave a contact number which may be required by NHS Test and Trace; and toilet facilities will not be available. Thank you for your cooperation as we implement guidance issued by Her Majesty's Government and the Bishops of England & Wales, which help us to value, serve and love all in the name of Jesus the Christ. All liturgies celebrated in St Mary on the Sea Church are livestreamed so that as many parishioners as possible can gather as 'one body, one spirit in Christ'.

**First Holy Communion:** Parents of children who will be in Year 3 or above in school year 2020-2021 and who would like their children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Blessed Eucharist next year should complete an application form, available from the stewards' table in St Mary on the Sea Church when it is open, and hand it directly to Fr Andrew after Mass by Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

**Private Individual Prayer:** From this week, St Mary on the Sea Church will be open for private individual prayer before

the Blessed Sacrament on Wednesdays between 2.00 & 3.30 pm instead of on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.

**Reopening of Our Churches:** I am delighted that, from the weekend of Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will once again be celebrated in all three of our parish churches. After consultation with Deacon Stephen, Deacon Richard, Sister Ann Helen, Sister Bridgetta, those who have helped to prepare our churches for reopening, and the stewards, without whom they would not be reopening, I have established the following provisional timetable:

The celebration of Sunday Mass, with or without the obligation to attend, is at the heart of our practice of the faith – as Catholics, we should want to come to Mass, and so I am sure that all those who are able will wish to celebrate Mass in person and not just online, not least so that they can receive Holy Communion. I appreciate that this timetable will not please everyone, but it is manageable, both for me, since I have to be able to prepare for and celebrate all three Masses, and, importantly, for the stewards, who have to work before, during and after Mass to prepare the church, to welcome and assist us, and to clean the church after Mass. With the introduction of three Sunday Masses, there will be a change in the arrangements for booking your place at Mass, which will, from bookings for the weekend of Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September, be online at massbookings.uk – you may wish to visit the website to register now; those who are not online can telephone the parish office for assistance, and bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

Weekday Mass will continue to be celebrated in St Mary on the Sea Church so that it can be livestreamed for the sake of those parishioners who are not yet in a position to gather in church for Mass – no bookings will be necessary for weekday Mass, but attendance at Sunday Mass will still need to be booked. **The Sacrament of Baptism is the foundation of the Christian life.** The next preparation course will take place on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020 at 7.00 pm in Holy Trinity Parish Hall. Parishioners who would like their children to be baptised should complete an application form, available from the stewards' table in St Mary on the Sea Church when it is open, and hand it directly to Fr Andrew after Mass; this can be done before the child has been born. Once Fr Andrew has signed the form and the course has been completed, a date and time will be set for the Baptism.

**Stewards:** I am grateful to those parishioners who have volunteered as stewards; it is thanks to their generosity of time and commitment that we will be able to open Corpus Christi Church and Our Lady Star of the Sea Church from the weekend of Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020. We owe them, and all those who have worked hard since our churches closed to the public on 23<sup>rd</sup> March to keep the parish functioning, a debt of gratitude. All new stewards should attend one or other of the training sessions, both on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> September, at 6.00 pm in Our Lady Star of the Sea Church and at 7.00 pm in Corpus Christi Church.
