**Stay alert – Control the virus – Save lives**

**Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for September:** We pray that the planet's resources will not be plundered but shared in a just and respectful manner.

**Cycle of Prayer:** During the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for Fr Colum, Fr Tony, the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, all those who are working to protect us, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

**Celebrating Sunday Mass:** Please visit [massbooking.uk](http://massbooking.uk) to book your place at Mass next weekend; there are forty places available in Immingham, fifty-five in Cleethorpes and fifty in Grimsby, all on a first-come, first served basis. If you do not have access to the internet, please telephone the parish office for assistance with booking. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended.

**Celebrating Weekday Mass:** Admission to church for weekday Mass is on a first-come, first-served basis up to a maximum of fifty attendees.

**Coming into Church:** Whether you are coming to church for Mass or for private individual prayer, please bear in mind that social distancing must be observed in the car park and in the church itself, which means that a maximum of fifty people can be in the church for Mass; for baptisms, weddings and funerals, the maximum is thirty, with admittance by prior arrangement. **Face coverings must be worn in church unless someone is exempt.** Stewards will guide those coming into the church and ensure that they are seated safely; no one who is displaying symptoms of Covid-19 or any other transmissible illness should come into the church; under 16s must be accompanied by an adult; people from different households should not share lifts; care should be taken in the car park to avoid close contact with other vehicles and their occupants; you will have to sign in and leave a contact number which may be required by NHS Test and Trace; and toilet facilities will not be available. Thank you for your cooperation as we implement guidance issued by Her Majesty's Government and the Bishops of England & Wales, which help us to value, serve and love all in the name of Jesus the Christ. All liturgies celebrated in St Mary on the Sea Church are livestreamed so that as many parishioners as possible can gather as 'one body, one spirit in Christ'.

**Mass Intentions:** Asking for Mass to be offered for a specific intention is a beautiful way of asking our parish family to pray for that intention and, by giving an offering, you support the mission of the Church in our parish. Please give at least six months' notice if you wish Mass to be offered for a specific intention on a specific day in a specific church; if it is not possible to offer the Mass on the requested date, e.g., if there is no Mass that day or there is already an intention, it will be offered as soon as is practicable, as it will if you do not have a specific date in mind. One Sunday Mass will

continue to be offered for all the people of our parish (*Missa pro populo*), something which every diocesan Bishop and parish priest is obliged to do each Sunday and holyday of obligation. Mass intentions are published in the bulletin and announced during the prayer of the faithful. The suggested Mass offering in the Diocese of Nottingham is £10.00. Please place your offering in one of the brown Mass offering envelopes and leave it on the stewards' table or place it in the collection basket.

**Readers' Rota:** Please contact the parish office if you are willing to read in any of our three parish churches for Sunday Mass until the normal rotas can resume. If you are reading at Mass on this provisional rota, you will not need to reserve a place for Mass as one will be reserved for you.

**The Sacrament of Baptism is the foundation of the Christian life.** The next preparation course will take place this coming Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020 at 7.00 pm in Holy Trinity Parish Hall. Parishioners who would like their children to be baptised should complete the form at the back of each church and return it to Fr Andrew after Sunday Mass; this can be done before the child has been born. Once Fr Andrew has signed the form and the course has been completed, a date and time will be set for the Baptism.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** can be celebrated, in addition to those times listed overleaf, in our three parish churches from when they open before Mass until ten minutes before Mass; confessions are heard in a face-to-face ventilated environment. If you wish to celebrate this great sacrament of mercy, please inform one of the stewards.

**The Season of Creation** runs from 1<sup>st</sup> September, the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, until 4<sup>th</sup> October, the Memorial of Saint Francis of Assisi) each year and is dedicated to prayer and action for the protection of creation. It is a time to renew our relationships with God our Creator, and with all creation, as we join together in prayer. We give thanks for all that God has made, repent for the damage that we have caused and commit ourselves to take action to protect the earth our common home. This year, we have been made acutely aware of how interconnected we all are, and so we come together in hope that we can rebuild and heal our world.
