**Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for September:** We pray that the planet's resources will not be plundered but shared in a just and respectful manner.

**Cycle of Prayer:** During the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for Fr Colum, Fr Tony, the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, all who are working to protect us, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

**Celebrating Sunday Mass:** Please visit [massbooking.uk](http://massbooking.uk) to book your place at Mass next weekend; there are forty places available in Immingham, fifty-five in Cleethorpes and fifty in Grimsby, all on a first-come, first served basis. If you do not have access to the internet, please telephone the parish office for assistance with booking. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended.

**Celebrating Weekday Mass:** Admission to church for weekday Mass is on a first-come, first-served basis up to a maximum of fifty attendees.

**Coming into Church:** Whether you are coming to church for Mass or for private individual prayer, please bear in mind that social distancing must be observed in the car park and in the church itself, which means that a maximum of fifty people can be in the church for Mass; for baptisms, weddings and funerals, the maximum is thirty, with admittance by prior arrangement. **Face coverings must be worn in church unless someone is exempt.** Stewards will guide those coming into the church and ensure that they are seated safely; no one who is displaying symptoms of Covid-19 or any other transmissible illness should come into the church; under 16s must be accompanied by an adult; people from different households should not share lifts; care should be taken in the car park to avoid close contact with other vehicles and their occupants; you will have to sign in and leave a contact number which may be required by NHS Test and Trace; and toilet facilities will not be available other than in cases of medical emergency. Thank you for your cooperation as we implement guidance issued by Her Majesty's Government and the Bishops of England & Wales, which help us to value, serve and love all in the name of Jesus the Christ. All liturgies celebrated in St Mary on the Sea Church are livestreamed so that as many parishioners as possible can gather as 'one body, one spirit in Christ'.

**Lincolnshire Remembers – 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020:** All are welcome to an ecumenical online service of remembrance at [live.alivechurch.org.uk](http://live.alivechurch.org.uk) this Sunday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020, at 7.00 pm, to remember the human impact of Covid-19, to mourn those who have died and to look to the future with hope. We are also invited to light candles in our windows this Sunday evening as a communal way of remembering both our loss and our hope.

**Readers' Rota:** Please contact the parish office if you are willing to read in any of our three parish churches for Sunday Mass until the normal rotas can resume. If you are reading

at Mass on this provisional rota, you will not need to reserve a place for Mass as one will be reserved for you.

**The Society of St Vincent de Paul:** Since March 2020, our parish's SVP group has been rising to the challenge of helping those in need, the lonely and the isolated during the Covid-19 pandemic. Sixteen hours is a long time to be on your own, especially if you cannot get around easily – have you ever imagined what it is like not to see or speak to anyone for several days? Could you offer friendship to someone by giving 15-45 minutes a week, fortnight or month to befriend someone by telephone, visit or letter? Are you able to deliver shopping, collect prescriptions or accompany someone to an appointment? Are you able to help elderly parishioners with technology to enable them to celebrate Holy Mass from the safety of their own homes?
