**Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for October:** We pray that by the virtue of Baptism, the laity, especially women, may participate more in areas of responsibility in the Church.

**Cycle of Prayer:** During the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for Fr Colum, Fr Tony, the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, all who are working to protect us, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

**Annual Blessings of Graves** will take place at 2.00 pm on Remembrance Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> November 2020, at Scartho Road Cemetery with Fr Andrew, Cleethorpes Cemetery with Deacon Stephen and Mill Lane Cemetery with Deacon Richard. The 'rule of six' means that we cannot gather and process together for the blessing this year, but if you would like to stand near your relative's grave, Fr Andrew or the deacons will come to you, bless the grave and move on. If you would like the clergy to visit one of the other cemeteries, please contact the parish office.

The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended and all liturgies in St Mary on the Sea Church are livestreamed. Many parishes and other Catholic organisations, whose outreach is dependent on the generosity of the faithful, are experiencing severe financial difficulties as a result of the ongoing pandemic; if this is true about us here in the United Kingdom, it is certainly true in countries such as Kenya, where priests are unable to celebrate Mass at the moment, and are therefore unable to receive Mass offerings – Missio is not only supporting its own outreach but is also supporting them to stop them from going hungry, but can only do so if we support them.
