**Act of Spiritual Communion** – when you are celebrating Mass online, you may wish to offer this prayer with the Celebrant once he has chanted the Communion Antiphon: My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things, and I desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.

**On Remembrance Sunday, we pray for all who have died in warfare:** Almighty everlasting God, who sent your Son to die that we might live, grant, we pray, eternal rest to those who gave themselves in service and sacrifice for their country. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**We pray for peace:** O God, who have revealed that peacemakers are to be called your children, grant, we pray, that we may work without ceasing to establish that justice which alone ensures true and lasting peace. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Wash hands – Cover face – Make space**

**Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for November:** We pray that the progress of robotics and artificial intelligence may always serve humankind.

**From Deacon Richard:** 'For the last twenty years, I have run a small team of volunteers called St Michael's Stewarding Team, which has given many days of service to the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham by providing stewards for the larger pilgrimages that take place each year. This year, when the Shrine reopened to the public, we were asked by Mgr John Armitage, the rector of the shrine, to assist in stewarding throughout the summer so that the shrine could open safely to the many pilgrims who wishes to come. Before making such a commitment, as a matter of course I consulted Fr Andrew to see if he would release me from public parish duties over the weekends throughout the summer so that I and the team, which includes some others from our parish, could serve in this most privileged way in the shrine.

'Fr Andrew gave me his blessing for which I am so grateful as it has been an amazingly fruitful time. Last weekend, All Saints' Day, was the final weekend of the pilgrimage season, and I am now back until the next time I am called to serve somewhere. I will always seek Fr Andrew's permission, as deacons, who are ordained by the Bishop, exercise their ministry in partnership with their parish priests, the proper pastors of the parishes to which we are assigned.

'During the week, I have been part of a 24/6 on-call rota serving the parish in the Diana Princess of Wales Hospital. Although there is a roll for deacons in proclaiming the Gospel and assisting at the Altar, Pope Francis recently reminded us that deacons have a vocation just as important in serving the people in a more practical way and to go where there is a need, whatever the need may be.

'Once again, I would like to thank Fr Andrew for his wisdom and discernment in allowing me to serve away from our parish; I remembered all who live in our parish each Sunday when I was in Walsingham, and I ask Our Lady and St Joseph to continue to intercede to Jesus for us all in these times, and especially for Fr Andrew in his ministry.'

I would like to thank Deacon Richard and all who worked with him to ensure that the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham could open safely during this very difficult summer for many, and the prayers which were offered for all of us there. May Our Lady of Walsingham pray for our parish, our diocese and her Dowry of England. Fr Andrew
