Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for November: We pray that the progress of robotics and artificial intelligence may always serve humankind.

Cycle of Prayer: During the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for Fr Colum, Fr Tony, the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's and St Joseph's schools, all who are working to protect us, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Annual Blessings of Graves: I visited Scartho Road Cemetery, Grimsby, last Sunday, 8th November, and blessed graves therein; this Sunday, 15th November, I will visit Mill Lane Cemetery at 1.15 pm and Cleethorpes Cemetery at 2.00 pm to bless your relatives' graves.

Celebrating Mass: Until Wednesday 2nd November, places of worship are closed for most public liturgical celebrations, although they can open for funerals, admission to which is by prior arrangement with the funeral director. During that period, all liturgies will only be celebrated online – please visit the parish's website, www.holytrinitygci.uk, for more information. St Mary on the Sea Church is open for private individual prayer each Wednesday between 2.00 & 3.30 pm.

Christmas Draw: Please return all raffle tickets this weekend; if you cannot get them to St Mary on the Sea Church or St Mary's Presbytery, please contact the parish office and we will arrange collection. Mass in St Mary on the Sea Church will be livestreamed, and Mass in Corpus Christi Church and Our Lady Star of the Sea Church will be recorded and uploaded. Mass in Corpus Christi Church will have an overflow in Holy Trinity Parish Hall. Admittance to all four Masses will be by ballot during the third week of Advent, and there will be more

information about that in the *Sunday Message* in due course. However, if we are unable to gather in our churches in person this Christmas, Mass will be celebrated online at 9.00 pm on Christmas Eve and at 11.00 am on Christmas Day. Although this year we may not be able to do everything that we might normally do to celebrate Christmas, in our families, with our colleagues or in our parish family, Christmas has most definitely not been cancelled, and we will still be able to celebrate Christ's Birth as best we can with dignity, devotion and, above all this year, joy. Christmas is needed even more than ever this year – as we will hear during the Mass of Christmas Day, Christ is 'the light of men and women, a light that shines in the darkness, a light that darkness could not overpower' (*John 1:4*), and we, the People of God, will be enlightened by that light so that we can all not just carry that light but be that light in the world in which we live.

Email Scams: Please note that you will only receive emails from Fr Andrew, the deacons, the sisters or the parish office via an official email address such as those listed on the bulletin or else ending with @dioceseofnottingham.uk or @nrcdt.org.uk Emails can be verified by contacting St Mary's Presbytery (01472 342301). **If an email purporting to be from the parish is asking for purchases or money it is not legitimate;** it should be reported to actionfraud.police.uk

Pastoral Visits: Coronavirus is at a high or rising level throughout the United Kingdom, and national restrictions are in force throughout England until Wednesday 2nd December. However, if it is safe and legal for him to do so, Fr Andrew will always visit parishioners in the Diana Princess of Wales Hospital, other care settings or their own homes if they are seriously ill and need to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick and the Blessed Eucharist ('the last rites'), but other pastoral visits by him or other ministers are currently suspended. If you or a relative are in hospital, please ask a nurse to ask switchboard to contact the Catholic chaplain; if you or a relative are in other care settings, please ask a member of staff to contact the parish office (01472 342301; office@holytrinitygci.uk); if you or a relative are at home, please contact the parish office. We need to keep a record of all such visits in case details are required by NHS Test and Trace.
