Hands – Face – Space – Fresh Air

Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for July: We pray that, in social, economic and political situations of conflict, we may be courageous and passionate architects of dialogue and friendship.

Cycle of Prayer: During the summer of Ordinary Time, we pray for: a deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; those who suffer persecution, oppression & the denial of human rights; Europe; human life; and seafarers. We also pray for Fr Colum, the sick & housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's & St Joseph's schools, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Celebrating Mass: As you know, England moves into Step 4 of the easing of lockdown tomorrow, Monday 19th July 2021, and therefore we will be beginning to see a number of changes during the summer period, in accordance with guidance issued by Her Majesty's Government and the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales.

Just because legal restrictions are being lifted on Monday, the pandemic is not yet over, and I have been directed to consider the prevailing local conditions for the virus when making decisions as to what we will do where, how and when in our parish, since I am responsible, with the Nottingham Roman Catholic Diocesan Trustees, for the health and safety of all who come into our churches and other properties. Our churches are in a borough where, at the time of writing, there are 941 cases per 100,000 people – the average area in England had 304. Although HM Government has clearly stated that the progression from infection to hospitalisation and ultimately to deaths has been appreciably reduced through the vaccination programme, most people admitted to hospital currently are only partially vaccinated or not vaccinated at all, and I cannot urge you strongly enough to be vaccinated and do lateral flow tests if you have not yet done so. Thank you for your cooperation, which will keep us all safe. Fr Andrew

- **Booking for Mass:** Everyone who wishes to come to Sunday Mass should book a seat online at www.massbooking.uk; those who do not have access to the internet can telephone St Mary's Presbytery during office hours to book a place – telephone bookings cannot be taken after Fridays at 3.00 pm. Anyone who does not book a place can be admitted provided that there is space. QR codes are clearly signposted at the entrances of our churches, and everyone who has the NHS app installed on their smartphone should use them; alternatively, stewards will take your name and contact number. There is no need to book for weekday Mass, but you should sign in.
- **Capacity in Our Churches:** For next Sunday, there will be 110 spaces available in Corpus Christi Church and St Mary on the Sea Church and 70 spaces in Our Lady Star of the Sea Church; these numbers will be evaluated on a weekly basis in the light of Covid rates in our borough.
- **Stewards:** The stewards, who have worked extremely hard during these last months to ensure that we can continue to gather to celebrate Mass safely and lawfully, will continue to welcome everyone to Mass, assist parishioners when necessary and clean

frequently used touch points after Mass. Please remember to thank them for their ministry!

- **Hand Sanitising:** Everyone should sanitise their hands when coming into our churches; for the next few weeks, the stewards will assist with this, after which automatic hand sanitisers will be installed.
- **Face Coverings:** Everyone should wear a face covering while in our churches unless they should not do so for medical reasons.
- **Seating:** You will no longer be escorted to your place by a steward and, while we should fill from the front because we gather around the Altar, you will be able to choose where you sit. So, if you want to sit next to someone in particular, you are very welcome to do so - just as you can go for a coffee or a pint with a friend, you can sit next to them in our churches. Please take particular care when moving in and out of benches, and please move towards the middle of a bench rather than block the ends. 'Please leave a space' cards will be available for those who wish to put beside them so that a space can be left to allow for distancing. We should, of course, genuflect to the Blessed Sacrament, or bow if we can't, whenever we enter and leave our churches.
- **Movement of People:** We should exercise good responsible behaviour, especially when receiving Holy Communion during Mass, and should avoid getting too close to each other. Those who wish to light candles may do so before or after Mass.
- **Congregational Singing:** This will be permitted from Monday, and all those arriving for Sunday Mass from next weekend will need a hymn book; singing will be phased in gently, with a processional hymn, the Gospel Acclamation, the Eucharistic Acclamations and a recessional hymn being sung, with other parts being added in due course.
- **Your Offertory Collection** should be placed in baskets as you arrive for or leave after Mass.
- **The Sign of Peace** will be without physical contact: please say 'Peace be with you' while nodding to those near you.
- **Holy Communion** will continue to be distributed under one kind, and I will continue to sanitise my hands and wear a face covering while distributing the Sacred Host, as will any minister assisting me. If there are two ministers distributing Holy Communion during Sunday Mass, there will be two lines in the procession, and it continues to be recommended that we receive Holy Communion in the hand.
- **Toilets** can be used when needed; those who use them, or parents in the case of young children, should ensure that they are wiped down after use and the cleaning materials disposed of in the receptacles provided.
- **Leaving Mass:** After I have processed to the porch from the Altar at the end of Mass, you will be able to leave church once you have made your thanksgiving without waiting to be dismissed. Please remember to return your hymn books and 'Please leave a space' cards; there should be no gathering in the porches and please be attentive to others and their movements.
