Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for August: We pray for the Church that she may receive from the Holy Spirit the grace and strength to reform herself in the light of the Gospel.

Cycle of Prayer: During the summer of Ordinary Time, we pray for: a deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; those who suffer persecution, oppression & the denial of human rights; Europe; human life; and seafarers. We also pray for Fr Colum, the sick & housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's & St Joseph's schools, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Celebrating Mass: Everyone who wishes to come to Sunday Mass should book a seat online at www.massbooking.uk; those who do not have access to the internet can telephone the parish office during office hours to book a place – telephone bookings cannot be taken after Fridays at 1.00 pm. Anyone who has not booked a place can be admitted provided that there is space. There is no need to book for weekday Mass. QR codes are clearly signposted at the entrances of our churches, and those who have the NHS COVID-19 app installed on their smartphone should scan them to help prevent the spread of coronavirus; alternatively, stewards can take your name and contact number. Everyone should wear their face coverings and sanitise their hands using the automatic hand sanitiser dispensers. Let us continue to keep one another safe!

Beekeeping: We are looking into the possibility of setting up a beekeeping group next Spring, with hives based in the ground behind the parish hall. Please speak to Fr Andrew or email office@holytrinitygci.uk if you would like more information.

First Holy Communion: Application forms for First Holy Communion in 2022 are available from the porch of each of our churches; parents of children who will be in Key Stage 2 or above in school year 2021-2022 who would like their children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Blessed Eucharist next year should complete an application form and hand it directly to Fr Andrew at the end of Mass by Sunday 12th September 2021. Parents whose children were on the programme in 2020-2021 and who have not completed their preparation will also need to complete the application form as there is no automatic re-registration.

Corpus Christi Church: From this Sunday, 22nd August, all celebrations of Mass and other liturgies in Corpus Christi Church will be livestreamed. As it is in St Mary on the Sea Church, the livestream will be switched on ten minutes before Mass and conclude with the 'Glory be' at the end of Mass. The porch and toilet will be decorated this week. Once we have enough stewards, Mass will begin to be celebrated in Corpus Christi Church on Tuesdays at 10.00 and Fridays at 7.00 pm, preceded by Eucharistic Adoration, with Holy Hour on Saturday mornings alternating between Corpus Christi Church and St Mary on the Sea Church.

Mass of Thanksgiving – Sunday 12th September: we will celebrate a Mass at noon in St Joseph's school followed by a picnic lunch to give thanks to Almighty God for the blessings which we have received. We will use the playground if fine, and the school buildings if not, so please pray for good weather! Please bring your own picnic lunch; tea, coffee and soft drinks will be provided. There will be no 9.00 am or 11.00 am Mass that morning, although the 6.00 pm Vigil Mass will be celebrated as usual. Please mark this date in your diaries now! All are welcome!

Parish Meeting – Thursday 9th September: We meet as a parish family whenever we gather to celebrate Mass, but the easing of lockdown means that we will be able to gather for a parish meeting in Corpus Christi Church on Thursday 9th September, beginning with Mass at 7.00 pm; my vision for our parish, including the logo and mission statement, will be presented, along with a financial report and my proposals for a reformed parish pastoral council, with elected and appointed members, who will be tasked with taking the vision forward. This meeting will be livestreamed from the church, and anyone will be welcome to submit questions beforehand. All are welcome! Fr Andrew
