Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for September: We pray that we all will make courageous choices for a simple and environmentally sustainable lifestyle, rejoicing in our young people who are resolutely committed to this.

Cycle of Prayer: During the autumn of Ordinary Time, we pray for: the harvest, the fruits of human work and the reverent use of Creation; students and teachers; the spread of the Gospel; justice and peace in the world; prisoners and their families; all victims of war; and young people. We also pray for Fr Colum, the sick & housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's & St Joseph's schools, and those whose anniversaries occur at this time.

Celebrating Mass: There is no longer any need to reserve a place for Sunday Mass. If you have the NHS COVID-19 app installed on their smartphone, you can help prevent the spread of coronavirus by scanning the QR code in each church; alternatively, there are signing-in slips which we will keep for three weeks if you do not have the app. Please continue to exercise personal and social responsibility by wearing your face coverings, sanitising your hands using the automatic hand sanitiser dispensers, and taking care when entering, moving around and leaving our churches. 'Please leave a space' cards are available for those who wish to use them.

First Holy Communion: The last Mass at which the application forms for this year's programme can be handed in is the Mass of Thanksgiving in St Joseph's school at noon this Sunday, 12th September 2021 – I am afraid that no forms can be accepted afterwards! Fr Andrew

Home Mission Sunday – 19th September 2021: Each day, we are asked to value all in the name of Jesus the Christ, by exercising our baptismal mission as Prophet, Priest and King so that all may flourish. It can seem daunting to share such a personal part of our lives as our faith in Jesus Christ. However, we can pray that the people we carry in our hearts will encounter him for themselves through our words, actions and example, and next weekend, Home Mission Sunday, we will pray in a particular way for the Church's mission in England and Wales, and there will be a second collection to support the Church's evangelising mission in our country.

'Make Tuesday your Sunday': Sunday Mass is at the very heart of our lives as Catholics, but I realise very much that it is not always possible, for a variety of reasons, for people to come to Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday morning. Currently, we celebrate one Sunday Mass in each of our three parish churches – but if you cannot get to one of those Masses, why not come to Mass one day in the week? We aim to celebrate a morning Mass and an evening Mass in each of our three churches each week, and I hope that Mass times and locations will suit as many people as possible. The doors and windows of our churches must be

kept open during Mass, so please feel free to bring a cushion or an extra layer of clothing – do whatever it takes to be as comfortable as possible! Our churches are kept clean and safe, as they always have been, and you will be very welcome whenever you come into our churches to celebrate Mass or for personal prayer, especially if you have not been for some time! Parish Prayer Card: This card, featuring our logo, mission statement and new parish prayer, is being distributed this weekend; more permanent cards will be available in the coming weeks. We will begin to say the prayer together during Mass as we begin to implement our Vision.
