Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for August: We pray for small and medium sized businesses, that, in the midst of economic and social crises, they may find ways to continue operating and serving their communities.

Cycle of Prayer: During the summer of Ordinary Time, we pray for: a deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; those who suffer persecution, oppression and the denial of human rights; Europe; human life; and seafarers. We also pray for Fr Colum, the sick and housebound of our parish, the mission of St Mary's & St Joseph's schools, and all whose anniversaries occur at this time.

The Faithful Departed: Please pray for: Patrick Joseph Smyth, whose Funeral Service will be held in Grimsby Crematorium on Tuesday 16th August at noon; Kathleen (Kay) Harley, whose Funeral Mass will be celebrated in Corpus Christi Church on Wednesday 17th August at 12.15 pm prior to committal in Grimsby Crematorium; and their families and friends who mourn their loss.

First Holy Communion: Application forms for First Holy Communion in 2023 are available from the porch of each of our churches; parents of children who will be in Key Stage 2 and above in school year 2022-2023 who would like their children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Blessed Eucharist next year should complete an application form and hand it directly to me personally at the end of Sunday Mass by Sunday 11th September at the latest; those who have not yet completed a parish census form will need to complete that form as well. Key Safes: The access codes for the key safes in each church will be changed this week; those who need access to the safes should contact the parish office (01472 342301; office@holyltrinitygci.uk) to be given the new code.

Our Digital Ministry has developed rapidly fully integrated livestream facilities in Corpus Christi Church and St Mary on the Sea Church, and we are developing it further:

- All liturgies celebrated in Corpus Christi Church and St Mary on the Sea Church are livestreamed and viewable at [youtube.com/c/HolyTrinityGCI](https://www.youtube.com/c/HolyTrinityGCI). All who enter the sanctuary during liturgical celebrations, whether regularly, such as servers, readers and EMHCs, or for singular occasions, such as at weddings and funerals, must sign a consent form for the safe use of images before they do. In Corpus Christi Church you may be captured on the camera while at the front of the church, such as while receiving Holy Communion or lighting a candle, and no consent form is required since such movement cannot be reasonably avoided.
- Photography is sometimes used during liturgical celebrations in our three churches and in Holy Trinity Parish Hall, and images may be used on Facebook, Twitter and YouTube; if you do not wish your image to be used, please inform, at the event itself, a steward in church or the event organiser in the parish hall.
- The parish is looking to recruit someone to oversee parish communications and digital ministry; a part-time position with flexible working hours initially for one year, this is an exciting opportunity for someone who is interested in playing an active role in the Prophetic,

Parish Summer Barbeque – 28th August 2022: The summer barbeque is back! We will gather at Our Lady Star of the Sea Church on Sunday 28th August, from 1.00 pm, with food being served from 1.30 pm – a great way to mark the bank holiday weekend! Tickets cost just £5.00, which is great value for money, and are on sale after each Mass. We are also looking for raffle prizes, which can be left with the stewards or in the Presbytery.

Sacrament of Confirmation: Bishop Patrick will be coming to our parish to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation on Friday 26th May 2023. Those who will be in Year 8 and above in school year 2022-2023 who have not yet been confirmed are invited to take an application form, copies of which are available in each church, complete it and return it by Sunday 25th September. Confirmation is an essential part of our Christian initiation, when the grace we received in Baptism is 'firmed-up' by the Holy Spirit. Duncan Weston, who is one of the two lead catechists alongside Libby Mellows for this year's Confirmation programme, will speak briefly at the end of Mass next weekend.
