We will celebrate the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night, the fulcrum of our lives as Christians, for we are an Easter People, in St Mary on the Sea Church, and I am delighted that Fr Krzysztof and our siblings in the Polish Parish of St Maximilian Kolbe, Scunthorpe, Lincoln and Grimsby will join us for the Easter Vigil, during which Jazmine Hanstock and Jane Kitchen will be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church; the Easter Vigil will be followed by light refreshments.
